

# **Creative Connections Application Scoring Guide for Review Panelists**

### **About Creative Connections**

Creative Connections provides up to \$5,000 for artistic proposals in Minnesota led by individuals. Proposals must focus on creating access to the arts for Minnesotans and/or engaging with Minnesota communities through artistic endeavors.

## **About the Scoring Criteria**

You will use these three criteria to score each Creative Connections application assigned to you. Each criteria will be given a score from 1 to 6, according to the following scale:

1 = does not meet requirements

2 = poor

3 = average

4 = good

5 = great

6 = outstanding

## **Scoring Criteria**

#### **Proposal Design and Feasibility**

Are proposal details clearly and thoroughly explained? Does the funding request reasonably consider costs and timely completion of the proposal activities?

Refer to the answers provided for <u>Proposal Goals and Activities</u> and <u>Budget Proposal</u> in the application.

## **Proposal Goals and Arts Access**

Does the proposal directly contribute to the applicant's stated goals? Does the proposal clearly and thoroughly demonstrate how they will create access to the arts for Minnesotans and/or engage with Minnesota communities through artistic endeavors?

Refer to the answers provided for <u>Proposal Goals and Activities</u> and <u>Arts Access and Communities</u> in the application.

#### **Community Connection**

Does the applicant demonstrate a clear understanding of the needs or interests of the community or communities they will serve? Does the applicant's connection to and/or relationship with the community or communities position them for success?

Refer to the answers provided for <u>Arts Access and Communities</u> and <u>Community Connections and Experience</u> in the application.
